2005 Davis Cup by BNP Paribas Draw

The Draw for the 2005 Davis Cup by BNP Paribas was made today at the Madrid offices of BNP Paribas. Attached are the drawsheets for the World Group and Zonal Groups I and II for 2005.

The first round of the 16-nation World Group will be held 4-6 March, with the quarterfinals taking place 15-17 July. The semifinals, and Play-off ties for the 2006 World Group, will be held 23-25 September, and the 2005 Final on 2-4 December.

Davis Cup by BNP Paribas is the largest annual international team competition in sport with 137 nations having entered in 2004. The title sponsor is BNP Paribas, the Official Bank of Davis Cup. 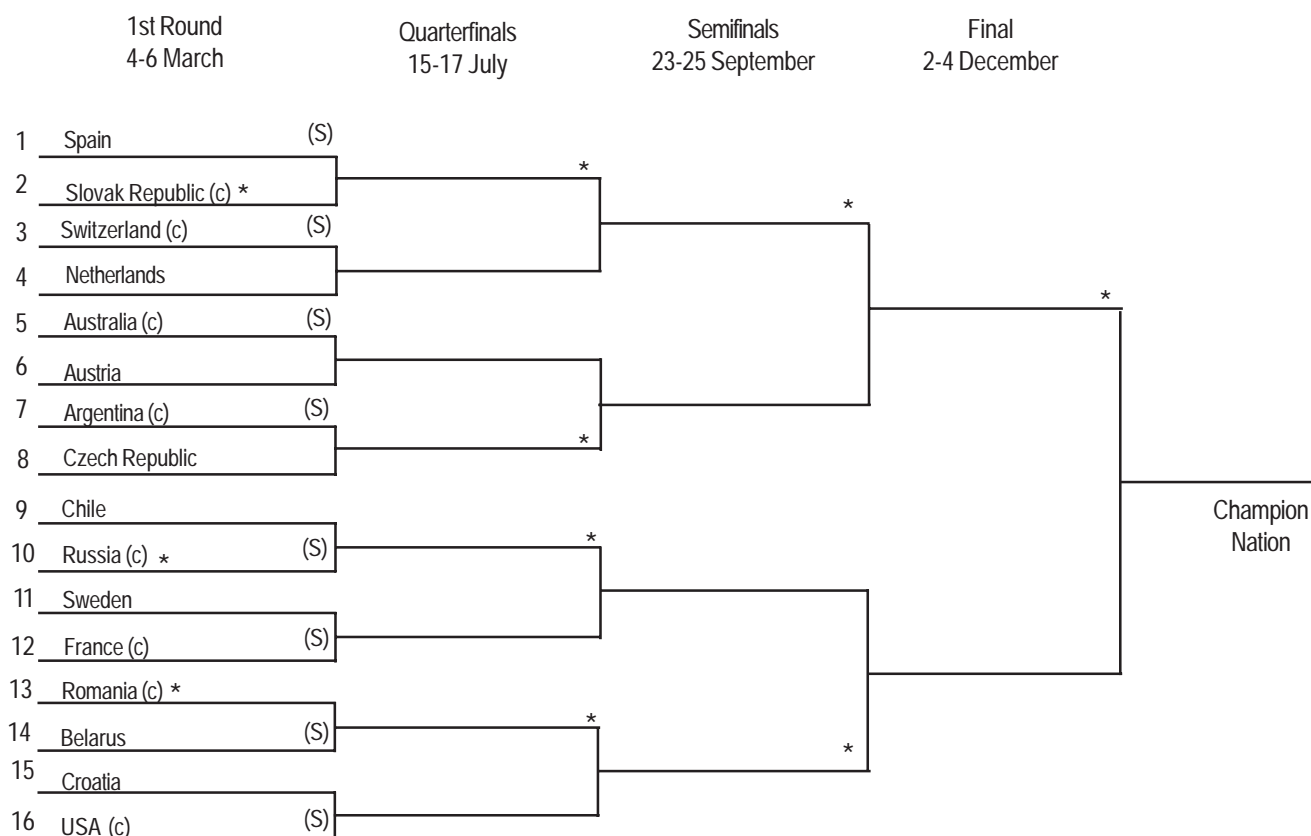

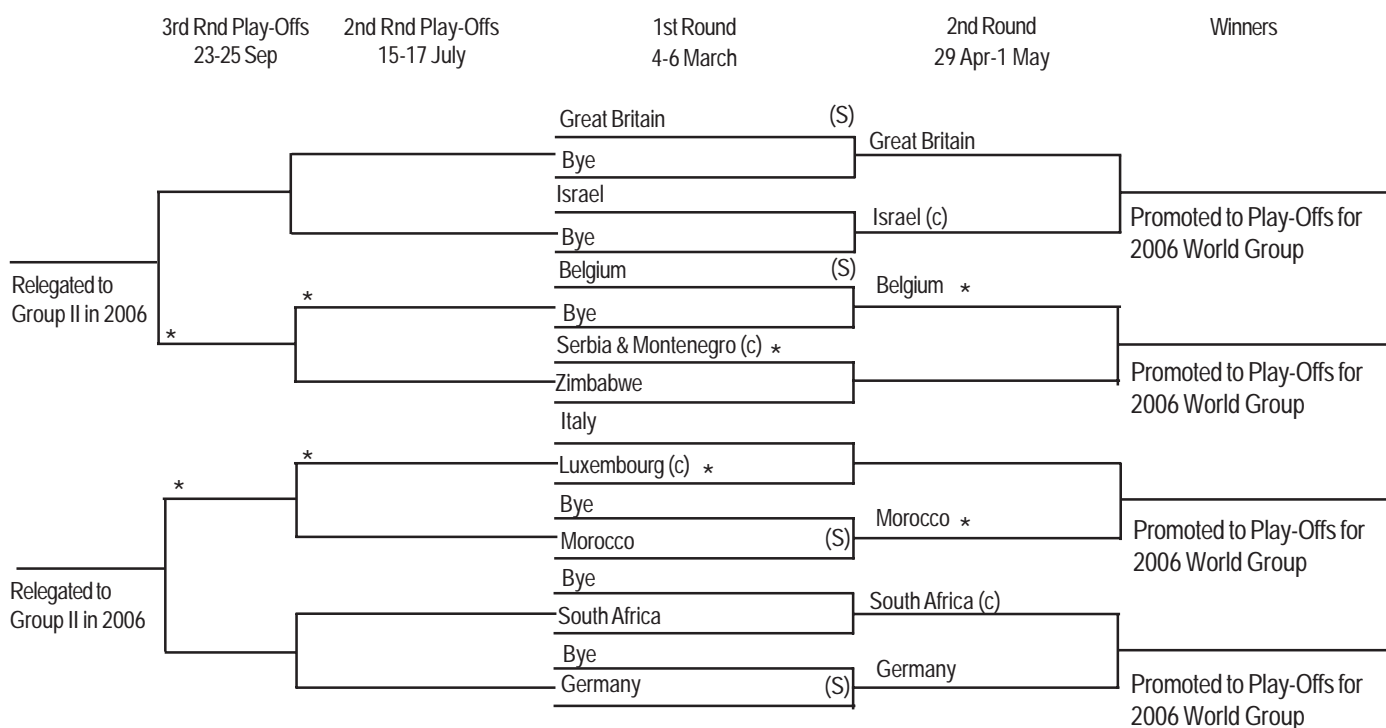

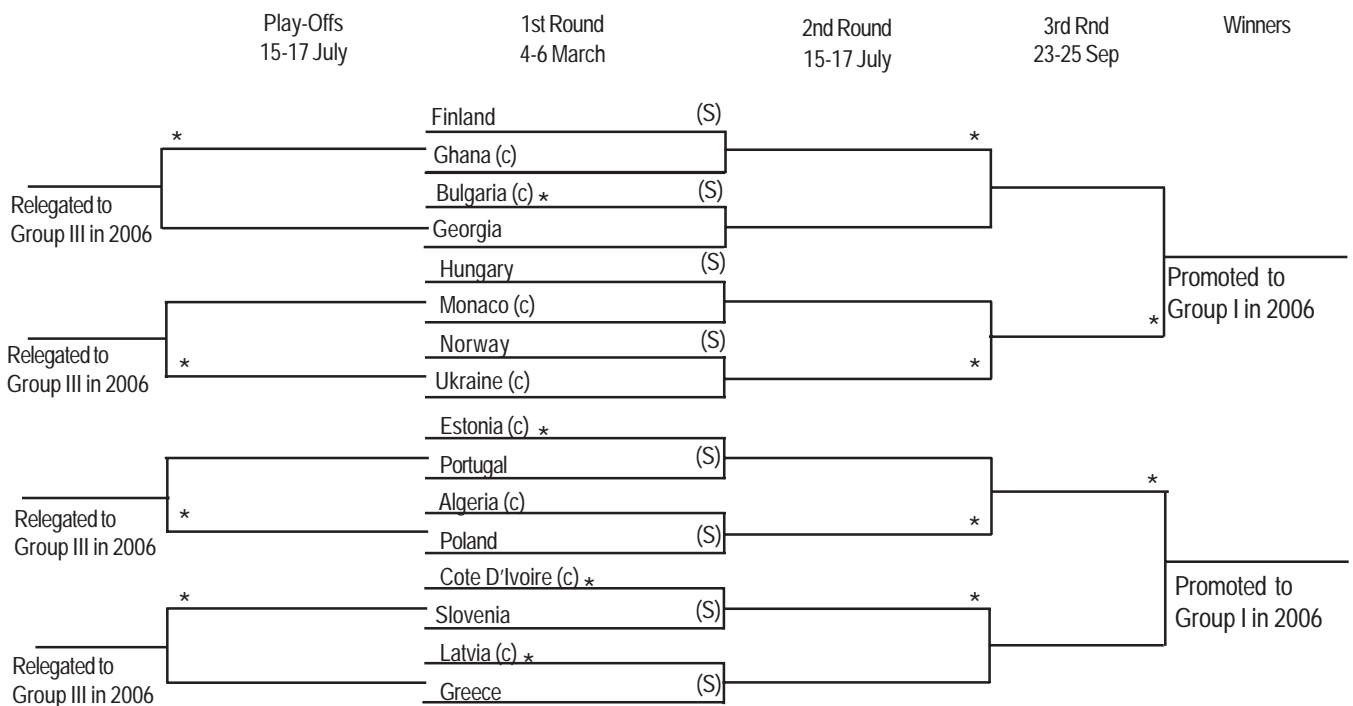

Europe/Africa Zone Group II 2005 (16 nations)

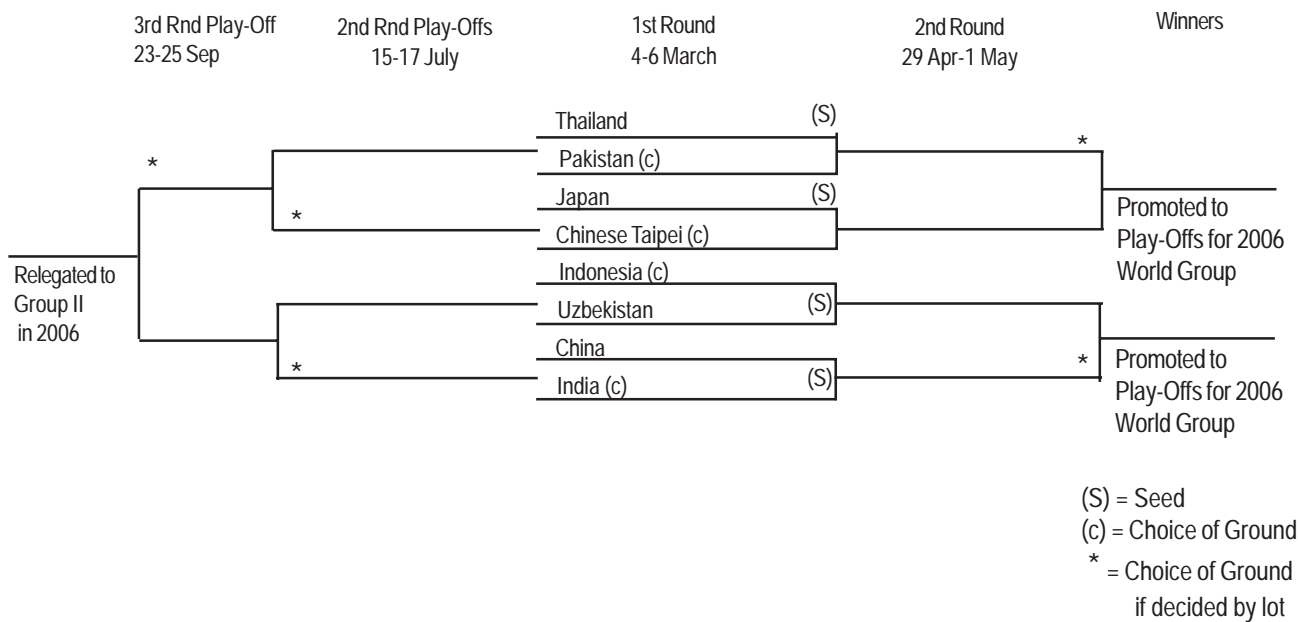

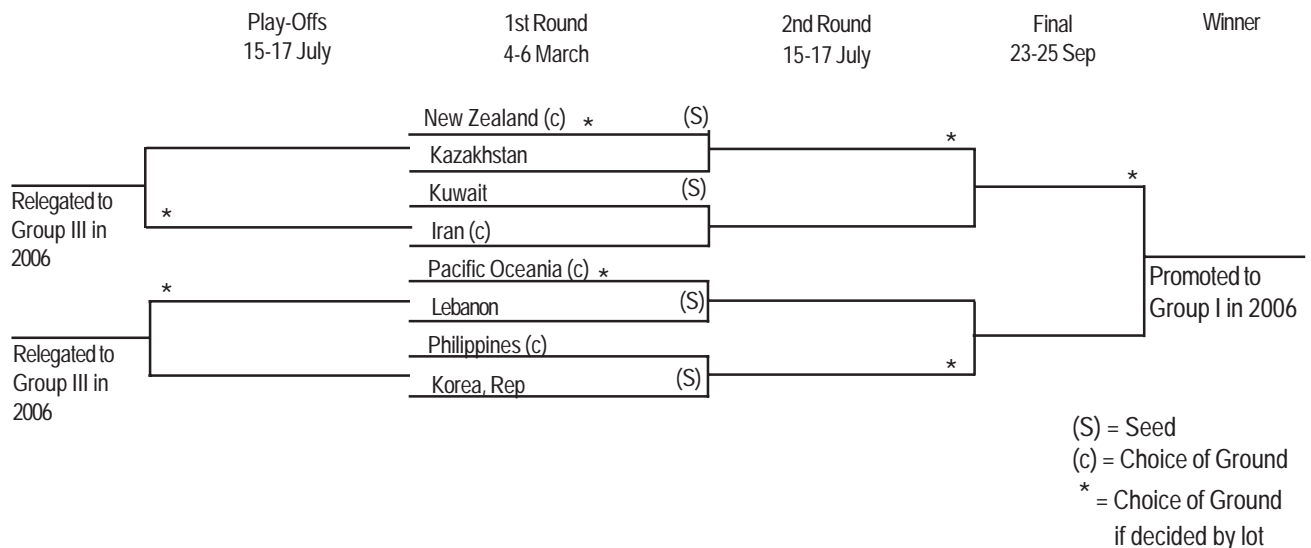


Asia/Oceania Zone Group I 2005 (8 nations)



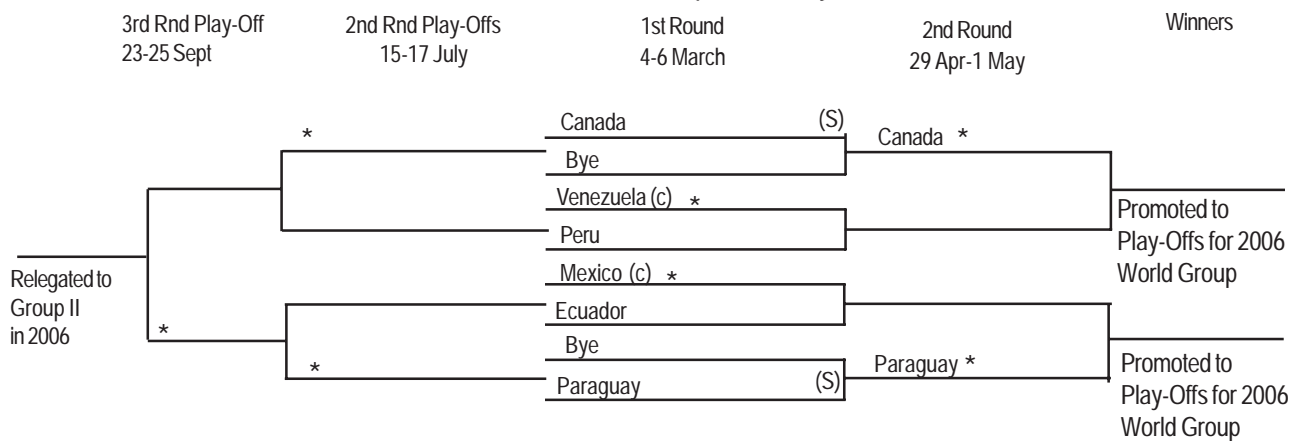

Asia/Oceania Zone Group II 2005 (8 nations)





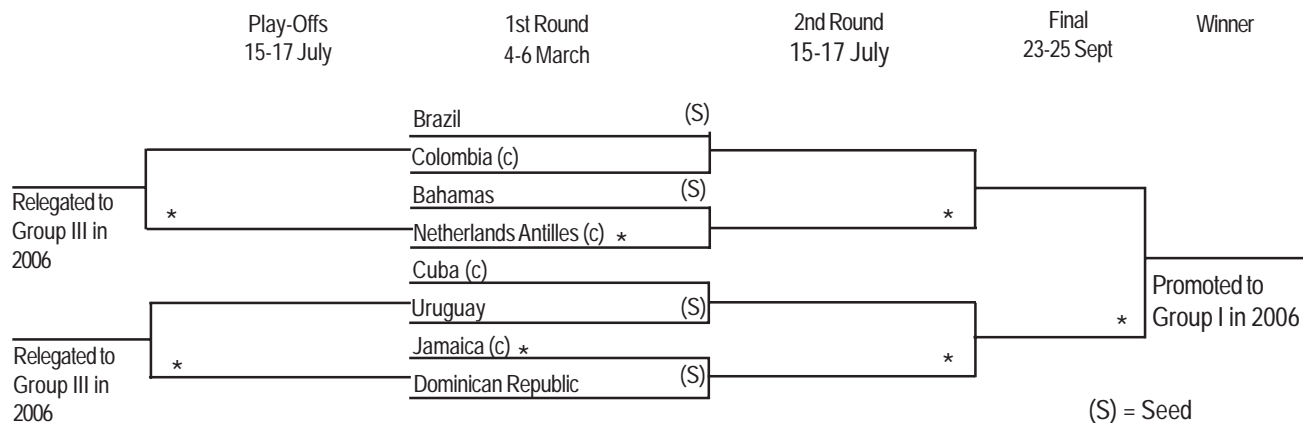
Americas Zone Group I 2005 (6 nations)
